Senate Resolution No. 183, 59th
Congress, 2nd Session, submitted
by Mr. Rayner.

Resolved, That in the opinion of
the Senate this Government has no
right to enter into any treaty with
any foreign government relating ...
to the public school systems of any
of the States of the Union:
And resolved further, That....there
is no provision in the treaty between
the U.S. and the Gov't of Japan that
relates in any manner to this sub-
ject or ...interferes with the right
of the State of California to conduct
...its system of public schools in
accordance with its own legislation:
And resolved further, That it is
the duty of the Pres. of the U. S.
to notify the gov't of Japan and no-
tify any foreign gov't with whom
the question may arise that the pub-
lic educational institutions of the
States are not within the jurisdic-
tion of the U.S.....
