Calls attention Sec. State to Rutgers vs. Waddington Case, in which Al. Alex. Hamilton won reputation. Is of opinion principle successfully contended for was that "the Federal Union was known & legalized in the Constitution and adopted as a fundamental law in the first act of our legislature. The federal compact vested Congress with full and exclusive power to make peace & war. This treaty (treaty with England) they have made and ratified and rendered its obligation perpetual. And we are clearly of opinion that no State in the Union can alter or abridge, in a single point the federal article or the treaty."
