We investigated complaint made by Frank Tatsumy of the Horse Shoe Restaurant, 1213 Folsom St., about his windows that was broken by a crowd of men on May 20th at 7:30 P. M. From information received 2 lathers entered the restaurant and orderd a teamster with a union badge on his hat and ordered him to take off his badge, which he refused to do and a fight started. Then the Japanese cook ran from the kitchen with a carving knife and threw it at the men who had left the restaurant and were on the street. A crowd of boys had congregated by the time and smashed the windows with rocks. Sheriff O'Neil has an attachment on the restaurant and all the property is moved out.
