Dear Sir:-

In answer to your application of even date for a license to maintain and conduct an Intelligence Office at 1513 Geary will state, that under the provisions of the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco, it requires the approval of the Police Commissioners before a license can be issued by this office.

Article VIII, Chapter IV, Section 7 of the Charter reads as follows: "The Chief of Police shall possess powers of general police inspection, supervision and control, over all pawnbrokers, peddlers, junkshop keepers, dealers in second-hand merchandise, auctioneers and intelligence office keepers. All persons engaged in such callings must first procure permits from the Commissioners. x x xx "

Upon receipt of permit in conformity with above a license will be issued.
