Letter to the U.S. Consul
copy & asking him to instruct
the U.S. Cons. to urge the Police
Commissioners to grant licenses
to Japanese applicants for passing
intelligence offices; explaining
to them the importance as bearing
upon the peaceful relations between
Japan and the U.S. and the
peaceable execution of provisions
for the exclusion of Japanese labor;
explaining to them that by dis-
criminating against the Japanese
now here in this matter of com-
paratively trifling importance
they would seriously hinder the action
of the U.S. in the much more
important matter of labor
exclusion.
